provides all Kansas City youth an experiential outdoor education program. LaCygne, Kan.

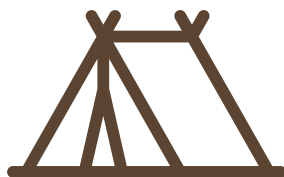

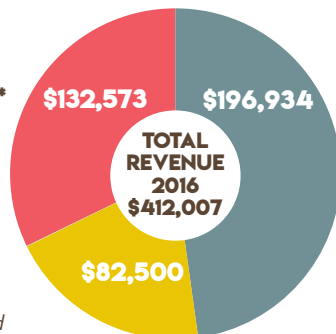

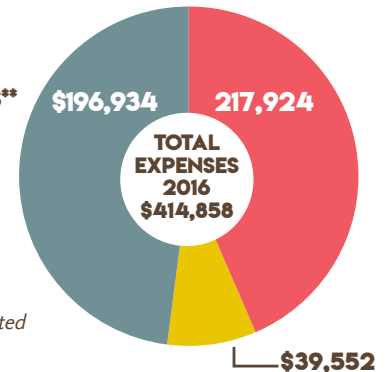
